## **ALPINE RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE SERVICE**

All Alpine residents have residential garbage service at their place of residence. There is regular pickup every Monday in Alpine Meadows. Residents can put up to four 32-gallon cans (without wheels) and should not be put out for pick up until after 6am on Monday mornings. Pickup usually happens by 2pm. If you use the 2ml recycling blue bags those will not count toward your four can maximum. The dumpsters located at the District offices continue to be abused. Below you will see pictures of what the dumpsters look like on a Monday morning, non-holiday when there is home pick up available. These dumpsters should not be this full when there is a four can (128 gallons of garbage, max 240 lbs.) pick up at your home as well as blue bags for recycling that do not count towards the four cans you are allowed. When garbage is left outside the dumpsters and/or the lids left unchained the bears are attracted to the area. This creates the potential for a bear human confrontation. The District is very concerned about this situation. The District would like to encourage you to use the garbage pickup service available at your residence. If the dumpsters at the office are full DO NOT leave your garbage outside the dumpsters.



The dumpsters are for alpine homeowners use only. No contractors should be using these dumpsters. They are for FOOD WASTE ONLY! These are courtesy dumpsters provided by the District for homeowners without a bear box at their residence.

If you are interested in a bear box, TTSD has a loan program available at 0% interest for five years. You may contact them directly at (530) 583-7800. Their website is [www.waste101.com](http://www.waste101.com) and has a lot of good information. Items not allowed to be left include liquids, hazardous waste, appliances, furniture, horticultural debris, construction debris, dirt, rocks, spa covers, mattresses etc. If in doubt, don't dump it!

Did you know that Tahoe Truckee Sierra Disposal has FREE Hazardous Waste Drop Off days every third Saturday all year long. Waste includes paint, cleaners, auto fluids, oil filters, medication and pesticides. You must call for an appointment at

**ALPINE SPRINGS COMMUNITY PARK**

Welcome to the 22<sup>nd</sup> season of the Alpine Springs Community Park. Park Use fees for Family and Single Day will stay the same this year. Large group fees and damage deposits were increased. The usual opening date of Memorial Weekend is the current schedule. Check our website at [www.alpinesprings.org](http://www.alpinesprings.org) for updates, applications and fees. Remember our parks are supported by user fees, so if you bring a guest that is not staying at your home with you, please pay the user fee for the day. You can pay at the front office or drop payment in the donation box by the bathrooms in the park.

The District office hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. A Park Pass Application is attached. Please complete the application in full, *including signing the application in the two designated places*, and bring it to the District office with your check, payable to ASCWD, or mail in payment if you are a previous pass holder. The District now takes credit card payments and there is a 2.5% convenience fee for use of a credit card. Pass fees are listed on the attached Park Pass Application and group use fees are on the District website. Group use requires reservations, waiver and a deposit to hold the date. **WATER STORAGE TANKS 4 AND 4A REPLACEMENT**

As we reported last fall the District awarded the construction bid to Farr Construction California dba Resource Development Company (RDC) on July 13, 2018 and issued the Notice to Proceed on September 4, 2018. RDC then notified the District that steel for the new tank will not be available until early to mid-November 2018. Actually, the steel did not arrive until the first part of February. The removal and construction of the new water storage tank is scheduled for this construction season.

**MAKE SURE YOUR BILLING AND EMAIL ADDRESS IS UP TO DATE-BILLS COME OUT JULY 1ST**

Bills are coming out July 1<sup>st</sup>; make sure the District has your correct billing address. The District will not be responsible for any mail that comes back as undeliverable and will incur a 10% penalty if payment isn't received by the due date. The due date is July 31<sup>st</sup>, and there is a grace period until August 14<sup>th</sup> before penalties go out. ASCWD also has a payment plan, but you need to set up a payment plan with the District no later than August 14, 2019 with your first payment.
